

APPLICATION PROGRAMMING INTERFACE (API) SERVICES

Overview

API is a set of codes that are leveraged for the purposes of integration between Day & Ross and a customer, allowing two applications to communicate with each other. In this case, API allows your website, user interface or business software to interact directly with the Day & Ross web services.

API Services

Day & Ross offers you the capability to directly integrate your website or cloud application via our APIs and access key functionalities that you would see on our website. This integration will enable you to offer a seamless user experience to your internal and external customers.

Day & Ross offers the following API Web Services:

- **Create a Shipment**
Create a shipment with an assigned tracking number.
- **Request a Pickup**
Create a Pickup Request with or without a Bill of Lading.
- **Get a Domestic Quote**
Retrieve a domestic or US rate based on your tariff.
- **Get a US Quote**
Create a quote for a US shipment.
- **Get Images**
Retrieve images for shipments.
- **Get Shipment Information**
Retrieve shipment status information.

API Setup Requirements

To set up API Web Service with Day & Ross, you will need the following:

- a unique Day & Ross web account with email and password
- an existing contract/tariff for the applicable account
- the setup instructions provided in a Word document
